Instructions for linking course

After registering for a subject, it is necessary to pin it to the programme and stage.

In order for the student to be charged for the subjects required in a given semester, they must be correctly linked.

1. To pin a course, go to the menu STUDENT'S SECTION and then click LINKAGE.
